

GOD WHO?

BASED ON THE SERMON: "God of gods"

THE BIG IDEA: This study will focus on the attributes of God [Not to be confused with the actions of God]. An attribute is an intrinsic aspect of who God IS. An action is something God DOES because of who he is! Attributes are an unchanging part of his very being.

PRIMER Q: What words do you use to describe the God of the Bible?

SERMON RECAP Q: What stood out to you in this week's sermon? Why did it stand out? How has God used the sermon to challenge and/or change you this week?

NOTE: There are many attributes of God. This list is not exhaustive, but I pray it will be a helpful tool for learning and trusting who God is and what God does in the lives of his children. (For more in depth study of this topic check out the "Bible Nerds" section on p2.)

Read the scripture for each attribute of God and discuss or reflect on these questions:

Q: What does this attribute teach us about God?

Q: How does this attribute help me trust God in my life?

Q: Is there anything else about this attribute that excites you?

ATTRIBUTES - God is...

Eternal - God has always and will always exist. **Exodus 3:14, Psalm 102:12, Hebrews 13:8.**

Good - God is the standard for what is good and he gives good gifts. **Psalm 25:8, James 1:17.**

Holy - God is totally pure and separate from the rest of creation. None are like him! **Exodus 3:5-6, 1 Samuel 2:2, Psalm 99:2-3, Isaiah 6:3, Revelation 4:8.**

Unchanging - God does not change. He is constant in all his ways and being. **Malachi 3:6, James 1:17.**

Just - God does what is right. **Genesis 18:25, Exodus 34:6-7, Romans 9:14-33.**

Love - Humans must choose love, God IS LOVE. The reason love exists is because God exists. **Deuteronomy 7:7-8, 1 John 4:8 & 16, Romans 8:35-39.**

Omnipotent - All powerful. **Hebrews 1:3, Jeremiah 32:17, Matthew 19:26, Psalm 115:3.**

Omnipresent - Everywhere all at once. **Jeremiah 23:23-24, Psalm 139:7-10, 1 Kings 8:27.**

Transcendent - We can not come close to perfectly describing him. He is so far above, so vastly greater than, and infinitely unique. **Isaiah 55:8-9, Isaiah 57:15, Psalm 113:5-6, John 8:23.**
